

Beverage Pourers

- For Beer/ Cider pourers: 1 taste = 3 oz. pour
 - The 3 oz. mark on the tasting glass marks the designated beer pour.
 - For Wine/ Sangria: 1 taste = 1.5 oz. pour
 - Please pour only half way to the 3 oz. line.
 - For Distilled Products: 1 taste = 1/4 oz. pour, will have pouring spouts.
 - Please make sure everyone you are serving is wearing the correct wristband.
 - Green Wrist Band = 21 and Over Red Wrist Band = Under 21
 - Everyone that requests a taste at your booth must present a tasting token. Please collect the token and place in the proper container at the booth.
 - Keep you token container close by and near the back of your table - guests will try to trick you into thinking that they already placed a token in the container*
 - You are encouraged (but not required) to sample the beverages you will be pouring, in order to impart knowledge of the drinks to the festival goers.
 - If you try alcohol from your own pouring booth
- **DO NOT** try it during your shift time
- **DO NOT** drink behind the pouring table - you have to be in front of the table before your shift
- **DO** drink responsibly
- We will kick out any volunteers that appear to be intoxicated

The vendors and distributors cannot pour their own products, but they will be in the booth to answer questions, make recommendations, and provide additional product knowledge to you and the festival goers.

- **It is possible that you won't have a vendor at your booth**
- If so: get to know your product/taste
- you will have to get your own product if you are running low
- in that case: if you run out of something, please take the empty bottle and return it to the sales room. That same bottle will be

EXAMPLE: You run out of Chardonnay - take the (6) empty bottles of Chardonnay, check them into the sales room and check out (6) new bottles of Chardonnay. MUST BE SAME PRODUCT!

- some vendors won't have product in the sales room
- For example:
- Some beers are in Kegs
- Once they run out - they run out
- talk to your vendor if they are there
- If a guest needs to rinse out their glass, please direct them to the water coolers placed throughout the festival.
- Additional tasting tokens can be purchased at the Granary Bar
- Full glasses of alcohol can also be purchased at the Granary Bar
- Images of pouring will be in packet as well as at booth
- Please don't overpour or give away alcohol
- Some guests will have different logo'd glasses - that's okay - as long as they are the same size/shape of beer or wine glass
