Application Requirements

• Must attach a minimum of 3 photos of your work, a headshot, and a short artist bio.

General Artists

- Cash prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, with juror voting.
- Artists can sell their art after the event. Art can be left in the museum for 1 month and can be picked up or shipped back at the artist's cost. Make arrangements with the museum after the event if you choose to do so.

Artist Requirements

- Limit of 2 paintings.
- Canvas must be framed and ready to hang with wire securely affixed on the back.

NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS.

- The museum must stamp all canvases with the date at the time of registration.
- Work on paper must be framed under glass or plexiglass.
- All work must be completed from life by the artist—no mechanical or photographic assistance.

Beginner Fee

- \$15, maximum of 20 artists.
- Ribbon prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, with people's choice voting.
- Beginners will have a 3-hour session with an instructor.
- Location: Ella Sharp Community Room Patio.

• Supplies Provided: Easel, canvas, paint, and brushes.
